


Infoflex 2022, Fort Worth, TX – USA, the G&J show preview

Dear Valued Partner,

InfoFlex 2022 is the first face-to-face activity that allows us to get back in direct contact with you, our customers. We will use this opportunity to present new features and new machines during 2022 dedicated to the resumption of full steam activities!

With the new fiscal year, that for G&J begins on April 1st 2022, the standard color scheme offered for solvent-based flexo platemaking equipment will change. The main color of the structure will be RAL 7035 (light grey) and some details will be colored in a darker grey, RAL 7021. This decision favors harmonizing the presence of our machines in work environments that use equipment from other brands to some platemaking complementary functions, such as laser ablation, film imaging or plate cutting.

The offered portfolio of machines sees the presentation of a new series of exposure units with pneumatic lid opening, improved cooling systems for both the ballasts and the fluorescent tubes, an efficient temperature conditioning of the exposure bed surface and a new management platform harmonized with processors and automated platemaking machines. The series is called *FlexiPose*, the red *i* identify - in the G&J portfolio - all the equipment with internet connection capabilities for remote diagnosis and firmware upgrades.

The first machines offered will be the FlexiPose 520 EC (exposure unit)



and the *FlexiPose 520 ECLF* (exposure unit and light finisher unit) to expose flexographic plates that require solvent based processing or thermal processing, in a maximum size of 50 "x 80" (1270 mm x 2032 mm).
